FIREFIGHTERS JUSTICE BATTALION

From its beginning the N.Y. Fire Department refused or failed to hire Black Firefighters or at best hired only the token few.

At the request of the Vulcan Society the U.S. Justice Department filed a lawsuit against New York City for the Fire Department's permanent practice of shutting out black applicants. The black firefighters won the suit with the federal judge ruling that the city had intentionally discriminated against black applicants.

Since the January 2010 decision the Bloomberg administration has been blocking and stalling implementation of the judge's order. The Judge wrote, "The City does not appear to understand that it has already lost the case, and that its obligation now is not to fight tooth and nail against the possibility of change but to move with alacrity to cure its illegal practices. Put bluntly, the Constitutional rights of thousands of its citizens are at stake."

We now have the sad spectacle of our Mayor blocking the firehouse door in the same manner early segregationists blocked the schoolhouse door.
